Food products derived from poultry herds are sold in small quantities at retail sale or sold directly to the final consumer.

MAIN REQUIREMENTS FOR ECONOMIC OPERATORS

The regulations lay down the procedures for the control and combating of salmonellosis and other infectious diseases transmissible to food products in poultry herds intended to produce food products (eggs and fresh meat) in small quantities and for direct delivery to the final consumer:

- Infectious diseases transmissible to food products are set out in Annex 1 of Cabinet Regulation No. 604;
- The amount of poultry and food products, which is defined as small is set out in Annex 2 of Cabinet Regulation No. 604.
