

## **FOOD PRODUCTS (EGGS AND FRESH MEAT) IN SMALL QUANTITIES**

### **SCOPE**

Food products derived from poultry herds are sold in small quantities at retail sale or sold directly to the final consumer. Keywords: foodborne disease, eggs, fresh meat, small quantities, poultry herds, food products, animal health, salmonella, tuberculosis.

Cabinet Regulation No. 741, adopted November 6, 2007 "Procedures for the control and eradication of salmonella and other by food transmissible infectious disease in poultry flocks intended for obtaining food in small quantities and for direct supply to the final consumer"

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### **MAIN REQUIREMENTS FOR ECONOMIC OPERATORS**

The regulations lay down the procedures for the control and combating of salmonellosis and other infectious diseases transmissible to food products in poultry herds intended to produce food products (eggs and fresh meat) in small quantities and for direct delivery to the final consumer:

- Infectious diseases transmissible to food products set out in Annex 1 of Cabinet Regulation No. 741.
- The amount of poultry in herd and foods to be considered a small set out in Annex 2 Cabinet Regulation No. 741.
